"Trouble on a Plane" To Begin Principal Photography in California, New Mexico and Colorado.

Maxime Brulein To Direct Hitchcock Type Whodunnit

(Los Angeles, February 19th, 2010) – Trouble on a Plane has been scheduled to begin principal photography in Long Beach, California, on September 12, 2010, under the direction of Maxime Brulein, it was announced today by Mark N. Thomas. Brulein has also been hired as the screenwriter on the film.

Based on the short film of the same title, Trouble on a Plane follows the back-story of three passengers on board of a private jet, when all three become prime suspects when a fourth passenger is suddenly found lifeless. The film will star some of the original actors from the short film, as well as Barbara Tarbuck and Peter James Smith.

The screenplay is being written by Brulein (And Vice Versa, Gone). The producers are Mark N. Thomas (One Note Too High, The Next Top Super Spy) and Aline D'Hondt (Why Fries Are Bad For You).

Other members of the distinguished behind-the-camera crew include director of photography Marq Lee (And Vice Versa), camera operator Yohei Tateishi (Dust), and makeup and hair designer Erika Garibay (The Next Top Super Spy).

Mark N. Thomas, President and Chief Operating Officer of Two M Films, said: "The short film Trouble on a Plane was a compelling, exciting and intriguing film, done in the style of the master of suspense, Alfred Hitchcock. But just so much can be told and shown in 8 minutes. This film, the feature version, will allow us to explore the lives and back-stories of these intriguing passengers."

From Belgium, Brulein said: " I have poured my heart into this project for the past two years, ever since the concept of the short film version of the story. It's a great thrill to begin able to push the story even further and give it more depth".

As previously announced, Barbara Tarbuck (Walking Tall, Gone, General Hospital) will star as Agatha McLaidlaw, an heiress to a multi national food corporation. While Tarbuck won't be playing one of the passengers, she will be a crucial character in one of the three back-stories.

Also announced is Peter Jamers Smith (West Wing) who will star as Mitch Mellbeck, a ballet director at the Philadelphia ballet. As Tarbuck, Smith will also be one of the featured characters in one of the three passenger's back-stories.

Hollie D. Larkey will star as Eve Kaplan, a famous and beautiful ballerina from the Philadelphia Ballet. Ms. Larkey played the role in the original short film.

The rest of the cast will be announced in the next few months.
